The Copper Island Classic Ski Race is one of the oldest Ski Races in the United States. It was started by Len Oikkarainen in Calumet in 1967. The race was sponsored by the Copper Island Ski Club for many years. The Chassell Recreation Committee began hosting the race 8 years ago as a way to help raise funds for our trail system, and to raise awareness of the joys of classic skiing. In addition to the traditional timed events, we have the fun race. At registration the participant guesses their course time, and records it on their entry form for either the 5km or 10 km event. They leave their watch with a trusted friend at the start and go ski with their respective group. The winner of the event is that person who most closely estimates their completion time. We hope you enjoy your ski.

There will be age class ribbons for the timed events, along with overall awards in the 5km and 10 km races. The fun racers will be competing for prizes donated by local merchants. The awards ceremony, complete with door prizes, will be held as soon as practical following the race at the Chassell Heritage Center
