Cost: \$56 for first two children and \$46 for additional children from the same family. Families with children participating in Ski Tigers are required to purchase a family pass for local cross-country ski areas. Please note that checks must be post marked by December 1st. For registrations made between Dec 2-15, first two children are \$70 and additional children \$60. From December 16th on – late registrations may not be accepted. **Make Checks payable to Ski Tigers.**

Scholarship Fund/Financial Assistance: Limited scholarship funds are available for eligible ski club members. Scholarship criteria will be based on financial need, commitment to skiing and character. Scholarship applications must be turned in with the registration form. * **Please pay at registration.** Your payment will **NOT** be processed until a decision has been made. You will be **REFUNDED** the registration fee should your request be granted. **IF** we were not able to award a scholarship, then you will be notified and can direct the committee whether to proceed or not on processing your registration.

Skill Level Assignments: In the interest of safety of all the children in the program, every attempt will be made to keep each group together on the trail. To help accomplish this, the Ski Tigers board of directors will place children into groups consistent with their skiing skills and abilities, physical endurance and interests. Graduation between skill levels during the season is solely at the discretion of the coach coordinator. Children new to the program will start at the beginner's level and be promoted to an appropriate group within the first four weeks.

Parental Involvement Program: At least one parent from each family must participate in one or more tasks involved in its operation. Each duty is assigned 1-4 points depending on the level of time and effort required, and each family must accrue 4 or more points total during the course of the season. I specifically **RELEASE** and **DISCHARGE**, in advance, those parties from any liability whether, known or unknown, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of persons or entities mentioned above. I agree to accept all responsibility for the risks, conditions and hazards which may occur whether they be known or unknown.

Being fully aware of the risks, conditions and hazards of the proposed activity as a competitor, participant, coach or official, I HEREBY AGREE TO **WAIVE, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE** any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have or which may hereafter accrue to me as a result of any participation in competitive events or training for competitive events, against any person or entity identified above whether such injury or damage was foreseeable or not, including any such claims regarding the design or conditions of any equipment utilized by me in such competitive events without regard to whether such equipment is specified or recommended by such persons or entities identified above. I further agree to forever **HOLD HARMLESS** and **INDEMNIFY** all persons and entities identified above, generally and specifically, from any and all liability for death, personal injury or property damage, resulting in any way from my participating in competitive events, or training for competitive events.

I currently have, and I agree to maintain throughout the time that I train and participate or compete, valid and sufficient medical and accident insurance. I understand that this is my sole responsibility and release all persons and entities identified above from providing coverage for me.
